Great Wilbraham Traffic Surveys

Monday 18<sup>th</sup> to Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2022

Further to the Transport Working Group's recent e-mail, this is to confirm that TWG will be conducting traffic surveys in the village from 6am until 9pm in the week commencing Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July. The purpose of the surveys is twofold:

- To count the total number of vehicles, of all types, travelling through the village on each of the 'through routes':
  - o A11 (Mill Road) to/from Fulbourn (Station Road)
  - A11 (Mill Road) to/from Six Mile Bottom Road (The Lanes)
  - Fulbourn (Station Road) to/from Six Mile Bottom Road (The Lanes)
- To record further details of Heavy Good Vehicles, beyond their direction of travel, as follows:
  - Size in terms of the number of rear axles
  - Registration number
  - Owner/operator details

The information gathered will be used as evidence in support of proposals that the TWG may make to the Parish Council, all of which will seek to reduce the impact of traffic on the village. The data collected will complement that gathered in September last year, over a similar 5-day period.

We are seeking 'surveyors': volunteers who are prepared to join others to form teams, which will work together to make an accurate record of the traffic. Members of the TWG will form the core of each team and will be responsible for briefing others on the process, shared between team members, of capturing, noting and recording the details required. Guidance will be available to assist the surveyors in distinguishing between various types of vehicles: something that was previously identified as a difficulty.
