HGV Traffic Survey

The Great Wilbraham Transport Working Group (TWG) is working towards assembling information that might help to reduce the impact of Heavy Goods Vehicles travelling through their village. Much of this traffic, of course, finds its way through Fulbourn as well, particularly along Station Road, Church Lane, Manor Walk, Home End, and Balsham Road, as well as sometimes along School Lane and beyond. The TWG undertook a traffic survey in September 2021, over a 5-day period, and they now plan to undertake a further 5-day survey during the week commencing Monday 18 July 2022.

They are now looking for additional volunteers to help with the survey. Although the primary concern of the TWG is the impact of traffic on Great Wilbraham, their survey will also identify HGVs that journey on to Fulbourn via Station Road. It is anticipated that, in due course, it might be possible to conduct similar surveys in Fulbourn to more fully understand from where HGV traffic is being generated, and its movement through the village.
