

## Week Beginning: 6<sup>th</sup> October 2025

Next week, we will be learning about...

### **Topic:**

We will look at our baby photos sent in from home and explain how we have changed. We will share our family photos and talk about our special people. We will spot signs of Autumn around school.

### **Phonics:**

We will be continuing our phonics teaching with the new phonemes, *ck (sock)*, *e (elephant)*, *u (umbrella)*, *r (rainbow)*. We will learn to recognise the tricky word 'I'. Using familiar sounds, we will continue learning to blend CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant e.g. cat) words.

### **Maths:**

The children will build on their subitising skills. They will continue to use 'perceptual' subitising – instant recognition – by saying the number of sounds that they can hear, such as claps or drumbeats, without needing to count. They will be encouraged to look closely at small quantities and observe whether the quantity has changed or only the arrangement.

### **How you could help your child at home:**

- Read with your child at least 3x a week. This week your child will have a library book and a wordless book in their bag. Share these together.
- Daily practise of the phonemes we have learnt so far. s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k
- Talk to your child about themselves e.g. What do you like to do? What have you learnt to do? How have you changed over time?
- Spot signs of Autumn when out and about. Talk about the weather and seasonal change.
- Share examples of recipes at home. How do they help us know what to do?

### **Reminders:**

- Please place reading records in your child's book bag or backpack everyday as we will be writing notes in them when we read as a group. The day of the week might change.
- Please return reading books on a Friday so children can be given a new book.
- Please return library books on a Wednesday so the children can change these when they visit the school library.
- Please send in or email a baby photo and a family photo ready for next week.
