Dear Families of children in EYFS,

Now that your children have settled into school, we are excited to welcome them to join the spring term clubs if they would like to. All of the information you will need to do this is in this letter.

Fulbourn Primary School is extremely proud of its enrichment club offer. It is designed to support children to experience and develop a wide range of interests, hobbies and talents that support their wellbeing now, and throughout their lives. The programme of clubs is constantly evolving to respond to children's requests, new opportunities and the changing seasons. Some of our clubs are run by specialist providers and others are led by school staff, who wish to share their own talents' interests and hobbies.

Our enrichment club offer is generously subsidised by the Wright's Clock Charity, which means every child can access one free club a week and book additional clubs at a small cost. Children are asked to commit to a club for a term and can then choose to continue in that club or try something new for the next term.

Below, you will find a copy of this term's club programme. Different clubs are targeted at different ages. The clubs your child can attend while in reception are highlighted yellow. A club directory, which explains a little more about each club, can be found on the school website.

Information about booking:

- Via ParentPay on the Reach More Parents app (in Attendance Meals and Events, Payer Dashboard, click on child, click on clubs)
- **12.30 p.m. Friday 21st November** - Booking opens for **1 free club** and will close at **9.00 a.m. on Wednesday 25th November**. Please refresh your browser to view clubs as they become live.
- **Please only book one free club per child on 21st November. Booking multiple clubs on this day will result in all of your bookings being cancelled as it prevents other children from accessing their preferred club.**
- **2.30 p.m. Friday 28th November** - All parents are invited to book as many further clubs as they would like, as well as choir, for a small charge of £3.25 per club per child. This will be on a first-come first-served basis, and clubs will become live from 12.30 p.m. **Please refresh your browser to view clubs as they become live.**
- **9.00 a.m. Wednesday 3rd December** - Club booking closes and no changes will be made after this date.

Important information:

- All clubs will run from Tuesday 6th January to Friday 27th March. **Please note there will be no clubs the week beginning Monday 9th February due to parent consultations.**
- Choir will remain free for all children *in addition* to their free club. You will be able to book choir from Friday 28th November.
- Clubs require a minimum of 8 participants to be viable. You will be contacted as soon as possible if a club has too few participants to run.
