Booking:

- Via ParentPay on the Reach More Parents app (in Attendance Meals and Events, Payer Dashboard, click on child, click on clubs)
- **12.30 p.m. Thursday 26th February** - Booking opens for **1 free club** and will close at **12.30 p.m. on Monday 2nd March. Please refresh your browser to view clubs as they become live.**
- ***Please only book one free club per child on Thursday 26th February. Booking multiple clubs on this day will result in all of your bookings being cancelled as it prevents other children from accessing their preferred club.***
- **12.30 p.m. Thursday 5th March** - All parents are invited to book as many further clubs as they would like, as well as choir, for a small charge of £3.25 per club per child. This will be on a first-come first-served basis, and clubs will become live from 12.30 p.m. **Please refresh your browser to view clubs as they become live.**
- **12.30 p.m. Monday 9th March** - Club booking closes and no changes will be made after this date.

Important information:

- All clubs will run from Monday 13th April to Friday 10th July
- Choir will remain free for all children *in addition* to their free club and will be available to book when the paid clubs go live.
- Each club requires a minimum number of participants to be financially viable. You will be contacted as soon as possible if a club has too few participants to run.
- Cooking clubs – the curriculum is repeated termly. If your child has previously attended this club, they may wish to try something new rather than repeat the same activities again.
- Forest school requires an additional £3.25 fee weekly as it is a 2-hour club.
