## Exciting new clubs for Autumn:

Come Sing & Play – Join Mr Brinsdon for a fun music making and exploration session! The children will learn songs, experiment with a range of instruments, and develop their performance skills and confidence.

Create & Record – Join Mr Brinsdon for a digital music making session. The children will use technology to generate and play their own compositions.

Story Suitcase – Go on a reading adventure with Ms Lord, exploring books and stories together. Children will have the opportunity to share their current favourites, discuss books, and listen to stories read by Ms Lord - and each other!

Community Club – An ideal opportunity for children who would like to contribute to improving the village environment. The group will go out in the local area to do a variety of tasks each week with Miss Crowe.

Non-contact Boxercise - Learning footwork, shadow boxing and some boxing moves to help balance and fitness.

## Booking:

- Via ParentPay on the Reach More Parents app (in *attendance meals and events*, *Payer dashboard*, click on *child*, click on *clubs*)
- **18.00 Monday 22nd June** - Booking opens for **1 free club** and will close at **10.00 a.m. on Thursday 25th June**. **Bookings will be rolled out one by one from 6.00 p.m.**
- ***Please only book one free club per child on Monday 22nd June. Booking multiple clubs on this day will result in all bookings being cancelled as it prevents other children from accessing their preferred club.***
- **18.00 Monday 29th June** - All parents are invited to book as many further clubs as they would like, as well as choir, for a small charge of £3.50 per club per child. This will be on a first-come first-served basis and will be rolled out one by one from 6.00 p.m.
- **10.00 a.m. Thursday 2nd July** - Club booking closes and no changes will be made after this date.

## Important information:

- All clubs will run from Monday 14<sup>th</sup> September to Friday 11<sup>th</sup> December. **Please note the school will be closed on Monday 2nd November for staff training.**
- There will be no clubs running the w/c 19<sup>th</sup> October due to Parents Evening.
- Choir will remain free for all children *in addition* to their free club and will be available to book when the paid clubs go live.
- Each club requires a minimum number of participants to be financially viable. You will be contacted as soon as possible if a club has too few participants to run.
- Cooking clubs – the curriculum is repeated termly. If your child has previously attended this club, they may wish to try something new rather than repeat the same activities again.
