Our Topic is.....
We're going on an adventure!

Next week, we will be learning about.....

Topic:

We will continue to explore the text 'The Little Red Hen'. We will make a loaf of bread and create a map for the Little Red Hen.

Phonics:

We will learn 4 new phonemes. v (volcano), w (wave), x (box) and y (yoyo).

Maths:

The comparison of quantities is something that children begin to do as babies. When comparing, children notice attributes and begin to understand similarities and differences. This week's activities focus on further developing these innate skills. The children will be encouraged to compare the number of objects in 2 sets by matching them 1:1. Seeing that objects in some sets can be matched without any being left over will draw the children's attention to instances when the quantities of objects are equal.

How you could help your child at home:

- Read with your child daily – Your child will take home a book that includes words using the sounds we have learnt so far. Practice identifying the sounds and blending them together.
- Set up a picnic area for your teddies with plates, cups, food, etc. Do we have the right amount?
- Provide opportunities during the day for the children to match real-world objects and see if there are 'enough', e.g. setting the table for snack time, giving out pencils to the children, etc.
