Next week, we will be learning about.....

Topic:

We will be focusing on our EYFS and KS1 Christmas production this week. We will continue to learn the story of The Three Little Pigs. We will look for facts about pigs and discuss whether it is fair that people think wolves are 'bad'. In music we will continue to practice the songs from Hey Ewe and learn a dance which we will perform.

Phonics: We will be reviewing all the phonemes we have learnt so far this year, with a focus on digraphs. We will use the formation phrases to support us with our letter formation. We are trying to start and finish each letter in the correct place and even put some letters on the line.

Maths: The children will explore positional language. This refers to the place where something or someone is, often in relation to other things, such as over, under, beside or beneath. Teaching children about positional words will build their ability to follow and give directions and use language accurately.

How you could help your child at home:

- Enjoy listening to your child reading their phonics book with you at home and read for pleasure with them as much as possible.
- Continue to read and practise phonics sounds with your child.
- Create a poster for our Christmas Production 'Hey Ewe'.
