Next week, we will be learning about.....

Topic:

Phonics: We will continue to consolidate all our learning so far in phonics. We will be reviewing these sounds again: ch sh th ng and nk and focus on our letter formation.

Maths: The children will continue to explore positional language. We will be reading the story 'Rosie's Walk' and acting out her journey around the farm. The children will follow instructions and practise using positional language with their friends.

How you could help your child at home:

- Enjoy listening to your child reading their phonics book with you at home and read for pleasure with them as much as possible.
- Continue to read and practise phonics sounds with your child.
- Send up some photos of your family's Christmas traditions for your child to share with the class.
- Practise using positional language at home when playing a game or giving instructions - 'under, next to, behind, on top, in front, beside, between'.
