Dear Families,

School Trips

We know that school trips and visits are both a central aspect of our curriculum and some of the most memorable experiences our children recall from primary school. Lots of you have told us that with financial times so challenging, you would like as much notice as possible to contribute to school trips.

To help with this, we have planned for all contributions towards trips and visits this year to be paid in termly payments. Rather than unexpectedly being asked to pay for an upcoming trip, we will ask families to make a termly contribution which will cover trips, visits, visitors to school and in KS2 a £6 contribution towards coach costs for swimming (£1 per week).

The payments will be as follows:

By 20th October £25 By 30th January £20 By 24th May £25

All termly payments will be paid on MCAS (under the Products tab on the left hand menu)
Any residential trips in KS2 will be charged separately with payment plans
Families in receipt of pupil premium will be offered the usual reduction funded by the government
The school does not profit from school trips
