## Re: Year 5/6 Relationships and Sex Education (RSE)

Next half-term, our PSHE (Personal, Social and Health Education) curriculum will cover 'Relationships and Sex Education' (RSE). We are writing to let you know what learning we will be covering and to invite parents and carers to discuss and view the materials.

At an age-appropriate level, the pupils will be learning about:

- Personal hygiene
- Changes during puberty
- The facts of the human life cycle including procreative sexual intercourse
- The stages of pregnancy including birth
- The concepts of love, trust and consent in relationships, especially intimate relationships

Each aspect is dealt with as factually as possible. At times, lessons will be delivered in gender specific groups when appropriate.

Throughout this learning the children will have access to a 'Talk Box' where they can post, anonymously, any questions which they may have. These questions can then be answered by us.

We will be using the Channel Four 'Living and Growing Resources' to support the delivery of our RSE curriculum, supplemented by the Collins 'My Life' resources. These resources are recommended by the Cambridgeshire Primary Personal Development Programme. We feel that it is important to offer parents and carers an opportunity to view a sample of the lesson resources and discuss any questions you may have.
