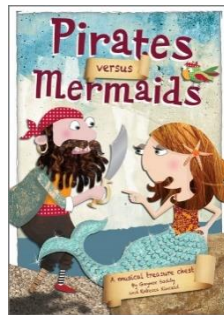


Pirates vs Mermaids – Costumes

Costume ideas:

Pirate – Traditional pirate outfits – hooks, eye patches etc but no parrots!

Professor/Headteacher – Pirate outfits, but in addition mortar boards for Fork, Doubloon and the Head Teacher, a chef's hat for Scurvy and Cannonball should be dressed as a P.E. teacher, but with an eye patch and pirate hat.

Mermaid/Merman – Summery clothes e.g. long skirts or trousers (with a little material attached for a tail) and a top. You could make some sparkly jewellery or some starfish etc, which could be pinned to the hair or body.

The 'Sea' / Stage Crew – Blue/green clothes which could have sea creatures stuck on e.g. fish, crabs, starfish.

Parrot – Clothes need to be as bright as possible with an eye patch and pirate hat. You could stick lots of colourful feathers to an old t-shirt and trousers.

Crocodile – Plain brown or dark green clothes. You could get creative with some large cardboard to create a scaly back and head that could be attached to the child's back.

Head of Security – Smart, business-like clothes e.g. a suit.

Delivery Man – Casual clothes of your choice, ideally all one colour, maybe with a cap and jacket.

Narrator/Announcer – Smart clothes of your choice, ideally with something sea-themed as an accessory!

Chorus – A pirate outfit, a mermaid/merman outfit or something sea themed e.g. all blue.
