## **Important Information Regarding Summer Term Clubs**

We are looking forward to welcoming the children back after Easter and beginning our new term of before and after school enrichment clubs from 15<sup>th</sup> April. Every term, the clubs programme has grown and we are delighted that so many children enjoy developing talents, interests and hobbies with us each week. With nearly 500 club places now being managed each week, we are making some slight changes to keep drop-off and pick-up smooth and safe for all of our families.

## **Morning Clubs**

Morning clubs begin at **8.00 a.m.** and we ask that children **arrive promptly** ready for the start of the morning. Club leaders will collect children from the main school entrance at 8.00 a.m. Club registers will close at 8.05 a.m. **Any children arriving late after 8.05 a.m. will need to be signed in to school at the main reception by their parent/carer.** 

## **Afternoon Clubs**

To help avoid the general busyness and congestion of collection time in the carpark in the afternoon, **parents** will collect children from their after-school clubs at different doors. Parents and carers can enter via the main school reception gate at 4.10 p.m. and go through to the playground. From here, children can be collected from the following locations:
